Banquet Speaker: Nick Socky will give a presentation titled *Windy Mouth Cave: Crawling Down a Dream*. It will be a brief history of Windy Mouth Cave (Greenbrier County, WV) discussing its previous exploration and survey, the inspiration and organizational plan of the current project, and the current progress, finds, and cataloging of the modern day survey. (About 18 miles of passage was surveyed in Windy Mouth before the project went into hibernation in the late 1970s. Nick has spearheaded the revived project and major progress is being made).
